

Ecology Director

Now hiring for an Ecology Director at Mitigwa Scout Reservation in Central Iowa. This is a seasonal 7-week position and requires the individual to take up residence at the camp. This position is for Scouts BSA Resident Camp starting June 3, 2020 and ending July 20, 2020. Room & Board included. No BSA experience required, we can teach you all you will need to know!

Position: Ecology Director

Reports To: Program Director, Camp Director

Supervises: All Ecology Staff

Objective: To develop and execute a variety of ecology related programs to meet the needs of the campers, in coordination with the total camp program.

Essential Functions: Must be at least 18 years old, able to effectively communicate, and clearly understand oral and written English. Possess superb leadership and managerial capabilities and have a high degree of personal integrity and dependability and meet one of the following:

- possess a current BSA National Camping School Card for Ecology Director or be able to attain one before the start of staff week in June
- have a degree in a related field or have 2 years of college in a related field.

Specific Responsibilities: Develop a well-rounded Ecology program that will provide campers and leaders and enjoyable and meaningful camp experience. Specific responsibilities are:

- Supervise, train, and motivate the ecology staff
- Keep Program Director informed of operations
- Be familiar with, and assist in, the enforcement of all safety rules and policies for the ecology areas
- Assist in instructing Scout merit badges and adult leader trainings
- Offer a quality ecology program to include merit badges, and open program times
- Maintain, inventory, security, safety, and use of all ecology equipment
- Set-up and takedown ecology facilities
- Oversee submission of each week's advancement reports on all ecology activities due at the end of week
- Submit staff evaluations for ecology staff as requested and written evaluation of all ecology staff at the close of camp
- Submit a complete inventory of all on-hand ecology material and equipment, to include the serviceable condition of each and recommendations for replacements and any supplies needed for next year's summer camp operation
- Maintain the cleanliness of the ecology areas
- Follow all BSA and NCS policies
- All other duties as assigned
